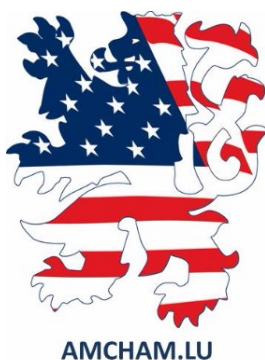
The conference will take place on **Tuesday, November 21** and will be hosted at **The Westin Warsaw Hotel in Warsaw, Poland.**
